



Dear Pro-life Democrat in New York,

You may have heard that our NYS Assembly decided to break up the Governor's "Women's Equality Act" and vote on the individual pieces. Great news – great victory! While the stand-alone abortion bill got an Assembly vote yesterday, it will not receive a Senate vote.

Attached is the Assembly vote on A.6221, the stand-alone late-term abortion expansion bill. The vote was 95 to 51.
